Turn the "No Zone" into a "Go Zone"™!

Avoid Collisions Inexpensively!

1. PROBLEM: Not being able to see cars in blind spots when changing lanes.

SOLUTION: At the touch of a button, with Go Zone drivers can now see what is beside them! Releasing the button automatically returns the mirror to your driver's original set position, so they can keep their hands on the wheel and eyes on the road.

2. PROBLEM: Performing a left or right merge maneuver from an on/off ramp or service plaza.

SOLUTION: Since cars generally don't give way to trucks, drivers need to be able to look out for themselves. By using Go Zone, a driver can see what is approaching and beside them with a reasonable perception of the distance between the vehicles. This enables drivers to make a safer, more well-informed decision.

PROBLEM: Making a sharp right turn.

SOLUTION: When making a sharp right turn, Go Zone enables drivers to quickly check and see if there are any people, cars, signs or other obstructions in their way before completing the turn.

PROBLEM: Straight backing up.

SOLUTION: When backing straight, Go Zone can help drivers check for vehicles, property or objects that may be in their path in their blind spots to prevent a collision.

PROBLEM: Blind spot backing.

SOLUTION: When blindside backing, switch the Go Zone control unit to manual mode and power the mirror out. When finished blindside backing, simply switch the control unit back to its automatic mode and the mirror head will automatically return to your original set point.
